Dear Property Owner:

The Taxpayer Relief Act was signed into law in June 2006. It will provide property tax relief to resident homeowners. Initial property tax reductions took effect on July 1, 2008.

The tax reduction will come to you in the form of a reduced assessment noted on your school district property tax bill. However, the reduction will not be automatic. You must qualify for the reduction by filing a homestead exclusion application with the county assessment office, and your application must be approved.

Enclosed is the application and instructions for its completion. The deadline to submit applications for property tax relief is **March 1**, **2009**.

You will receive notification regarding your approval/denial from the county assessor within 30 days after the receipt of your application. If for any reason your application is denied, you will be given an opportunity to appeal the county's determination.

Please disregard this application if one or more of the following apply:

- You have already been approved for your residence. (You can only apply and be approved for <u>one</u> parcel.)
- > The property you intend to apply for is:
 - Not your primary residence
 - Not owner occupied
 - Used as a commercial business or rental (100%)
 - Vacant Lot
