SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT:



Mathematics:

Pre-Algebra: Students will be introduced to what Systems of Equations mean and learn to graph two linear equations to find one solution. We will also begin talking about the Pythagorean Theorem! Algebra: Students will begin to work to solve Systems of Linear Equations and Systems of Inequalities
