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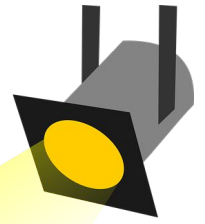

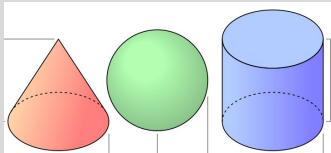
SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT:



Mathematics:

English Language Arts:

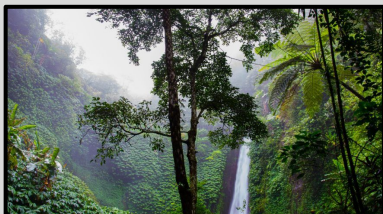
